Beach & Grounds Rules and Regulations

The beach and grounds at the Cove are for the private use of Lot A owners and their **accompanied** guests. The beach is in high demand during the spring and summer months, and has limited picnic, parking and rest room facilities. The adjacent wetland area has been recently restored and is a sensitive environmental site. To ensure that all Lot A owners have equal access to their property and that the restored salmon habitat at the Cove is protected, the Board has established the following Rules and Regulations for beach and grounds usage:

Fires are allowed only in the fire pits. Bring your own wood, do not burn driftwood or beach logs.

Extinguish your fire before leaving. Burning bans may be in effect (check with the Fire Dept.).

Do not cut or remove driftwood or beach logs. Do not remove sand or gravel.

Keep children and pets on the paths when in front of the building and out of the wetland area and pond when at the beach.

Evening beach parties are permitted as long as they are orderly and do not disturb others. The City's noise ordinances apply. No overnight camping or parking is permitted.

Beach parties of more than 15 people are required to file a **Beach Permit Form** with the Cove Office. Groups of more than 40 require a Board approval.

Teenagers 17 and under must leave the beach by 12:00 a.m. unless accompanied by a Lot A resident 18 or over.

The boat ramp is for the use of Lot A owners only at high tide. After launching, please move your trailer to the designated trailer parking area at the beach.

No vehicles, bikes or horses are allowed on the beach (WA State Law). Motor vehicles may park only in designated areas and are not allowed on footbridges, in the woods or in the field.

Illegal drugs are prohibited. Minors are not permitted to consume alcohol anywhere on Cove property.

If your dog poops, please scoop (NP City Ordinance 6.04.088).

Please keep your dog on leash or under voice control (NP City Ordinance 6.04.087).

Please place all litter in trashcans, or take it home.

Please notify the Normandy Park Police immediately if you see trespassers or vandals.
