The beach and grounds at the Cove are for the private use of Lot A owners and their **accompanied** guests. The Cove beach is in high demand during the spring and summer months but has a limited picnic area, parking and rest room facilities. To ensure that all Lot A owners have equal access to the beach, the Board requires parties of 15 or more to submit this permit to the Cove Office. The purpose of this permit is to help the Office Manager control the number of large groups planning to use the beach and to inform our Security Guard about your group. Please present this permit to the Security Guard if he is present.

This is not a reservation! Tables and fire pits are still on a first-come basis for all Lot A owners. You can attach a copy of this permit to a picnic table so that earlier users know that your group is planning to use the table later that day. Hopefully they will be good neighbors and vacate the table when you arrive.

In addition to following the **Beach & Grounds Usage Guidelines** (see attachment), as the **Lot A owner and host** for this function, you are responsible to

1. Bring your own fire wood if you plan to have a fire; **do not burn beach wood**.
2. Inform your guests about the Beach & Grounds Usage Guidelines.
3. **Extinguish fires** and clean-up your area before you leave.
4. Limit group activities to the beach and west end of field. Group members should stay out of wetland, woods and away from the building.
5. Use only **one** picnic table and fire pit.
6. Park cars in the **beach parking lot** only. Do not use parking areas at the building during weekends.

Normandy Park Community Club **Beach & Grounds Usage Guidelines**

Your Board of Trustees has established Beach and Grounds Usage Guidelines for the Cove. These guidelines help to insure that all Lot A owners and their families can have a safe and enjoyable time at the Cove. **Remember the Cove is jointly owned by all of us.**

If you see trespassers or vandals, please notify the Normandy Park Police immediately at 206-248-7600. Although we employ part-time security and the police patrol regularly, it is up to each of us to help keep our property safe and beautiful.

If you do not have a Cove Beach Pass, you may be asked by the Security Guard to show a picture ID with your current Lot A address. If you have invited guests, tell them to give the guard your last name when arriving at the Cove.

Guidelines

Fires are allowed only in the fire pits. Bring your own wood and **do not burn driftwood or beach logs. Extinguish your fire before leaving.** Be sure your fire is out; sometimes the fires reignite. Burning bans may be in effect (check with the Fire Dept.).

Please place all litter in trash cans or take it home. Do not cut or remove driftwood or beach logs; do not remove sand or gravel.

Evening beach parties are permitted as long as they are orderly and do not disturb others. The City's noise ordinances apply (NP City Ord.??). **No overnight camping or parking is permitted.**

Beach parties of more than 15 people require a **Beach Party Permit** from the Cove office. Groups of more than 40 require Board approval. Only Lot A owners (not their children) may have up to a 40 accompanied guests at the Cove..

All minors must leave the Cove property by 11 PM if un-chaperoned by an adult. Youth 15 and younger having a bonfire must be accompanied by an adult. There should be one chaperon per 5 youth.

Illegal drugs are prohibited. Minors are not permitted to consume alcohol anywhere on Cove property.

The boat ramp is for Lot A owners only. After launching, please move your trailer to the designated trailer parking area at the beach and re-lock the ramp cable.

No vehicles or motorbikes are allowed on the beach (WA State Law). Motor vehicles may park only in designated areas and are not allowed on footbridges, in the woods or in the field.

If your dog poops, please scoop (NP City Ord. 6.04.088). Keep your dog on a **leash or under voice control** (NP City Ord. 6.04.087). If you are asked by a fellow owner to put your dog on a leash or keep him near you, please comply. **Remember everyone has a right to enjoy the Cove.**
