Pignoli: An almond macaroon cookie, rolled in pine nuts, a rich and chewy cookie from Sicily.

Brutti ma Buoni: A cookie named "Ugly, but Good" that comes from the Lazio region of Italy. It's a crunchy, chewy hazelnut confection found in shops all over Rome.

Cranberry, Orange and Pistachio Cantucci: A small biscotti served in Tuscany with Vin Santo, a sweet dessert wine.

Chocolate Almond Biscotti: A traditional biscotti made with cocoa powder and almonds.

Pizzelle: Crisp waffle cookies from Abuzzo that can be eaten by themselves or formed into cones or cups to be used as vessels for ricotta cream, mousses, fruit curd or ice cream.
