The beach and grounds at the Cove are for private use of Lot A owners and their **accompanied** guests. The Cove beach is in high demand during spring and summer months but has limited picnic area, parking, and restroom facilities. To ensure that all Lot A owners have equal access to the beach, the Board requires parties of 15 or more to submit this permit to the Cove Office. The purpose of this permit is to help the Office Manager control the number of large groups planning to use the beach and to inform our Security Guards. Please present this permit to the Security Guard if they are present.

- Lot A owner must always be present with their guests
- Lot A owner has paid current year's maintenance fees
- Obtain approval from Office Manager
- Lot A owner is responsible for beach cleanup, extinguishing fires, any damage to property and group behavior while visiting the Cove property
- Beach & Grounds rules will be obeyed by your guests
- Guest activity is LIMITED to beach and field near play structure. Guests should stay out of wetlands, woods, and away from the building
- If children are present, one chaperone per 5 youth is recommended
- Guests may use only one picnic table and fire pit, first come first serve
- One approval party on weekends, up to two on weekdays will be approved
- Parking is restricted to the beach parking lot only on weekends, parking at the building is permitted only on weekdays
- NO burning on the beach, fires are permitted in the fire pits only
- NO burning or removal of driftwood from the beach, please bring your own wood
- No food trucks or live music
- No flying air crafts
- Follow current Covid restrictions
