

Normandy Park Community Club Board Meeting Minutes SUMMARY

- **Cove rental bookings** are returning to pre-pandemic popularity! A proposal passed to raise rental rates- this, for a few reasons. First, our rates are lower than other comparable venues and rates have not been raised in years. Second, while we don't aim to turn a profit from rentals, our own costs have gone up (maintenance, janitorial, etc) and need to be covered. Please know that the Board takes its role of being good stewards of Cove resources as well as providing Lot A owners with an accessible, inclusive, and inviting property very seriously and make every effort to align our decisions to this effort.
- **Annual Meeting October 10 at 7:00 PM.** Meeting will be in person at the Cove building, no online streaming options will be provided this year.
- **Bucky the resident beaver** at the Cove continues to be treated with compassion while also ensuring our salmon have their viable run and the Cove property doesn't flood. We are in contact with Washington Department of Fish & Wildlife to find a viable option for dealing with the beaver (which will not include euthanasia or relocation). In the meantime, volunteers continue to disassemble the beaver dam as it gets built back up.
- **Drop in pickleball times** will be held twice weekly as weather permits for the remainder of the year: Sundays (11AM-1PM) and Wednesdays (1PM-3PM).
- **The Social Committee** continues to provide and support the Cove events- make sure you are checking out their calendar regularly! In September, they are kicking off the recurring children's book club as well as a class to teach people of all ages how to properly exercise at home with little or no equipment and keeping safety in mind.
