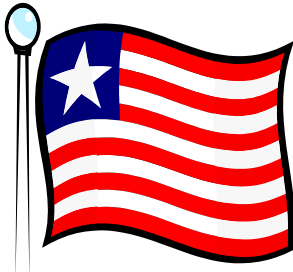

Thursday, July 4th is just around the corner. We hope that you are planning to participate in the community festivities from 10:00am until 2:00pm. The Board of Trustees invites ALL Normandy Park residents, their families, and friends to join the festivities.

The day begins at 10:25am with our 2.8K **Fun Run**, which is only as competitive as you make it. It's free. Registration will be day of the run ONLY. Registration forms can be found in this newsletter and on the website, www.npcove.org. The course runs from Marvista Elementary to Marine View Drive & SW Normandy Terrace. Runners should arrive at the starting area by 9:30am to complete their registration and pick up numbers.

At 10:30am, our **Children's Parade** leaves the Marvista parking lot. Everyone is welcome to join in, either from the start (be at Marvista no later than 10:15) or from anywhere along the parade route, which ends at the Cove building. Classic cars, wagons, bicycles, strollers, marching bands - - all are encouraged to participate. Paint your face, decorate your car or bike, get out your flags; be festive! Please, however, **no campaigning or political signs**. The Normandy Park Arts Commission will once again offer prizes to children for all decorated bicycles, at the NPCC Courts.

Once everyone arrives at the Cove after the parade (at approximately 11:15 am), free hot dogs, beverages, popcorn, and ice cream will be served. Festivities including face painting, classic cars to view, an inflatable obstacle course, a dunk tank. There has not been a fee increase since 2016, with the exception of the temporary increase in 2020 due to the loss of rental income during the pandemic.

2024 SUMMER YOUTH TENNIS CAMP AT THE COVE

The Normandy Park Community Club invites you to sign up for our Summer Tennis Camp! The tennis camp focuses on players who are working to master the sport of tennis. Participants can sign up for any or all four weeks of camp. Participants will be arranged into small groups of players with similar experience to maximize the learning and attention needed for each player to progress to become a seasoned player.



Our instructor, Kean Legate, is best suited for helping each player take small steps to master the fundamentals. As a tennis coach for summer leagues and varsity, and private tutor for 3 years, Kean connects with all players on how they want to approach the sport and makes the most out of every minute to ensure an engaging environment that speaks to the individual as well as to the team.

Weekly sessions of tennis camp will be held Monday to Friday between June 24th and August 2nd with hourly lessons from 8:30 AM to 4:30 PM, excluding the week of 4th of July.
